
Those not planning to attend the Rugby should arrive at the event for 1200hrs.

The 2026 Regimental Gathering will take place this year at Kendrew Barracks in Cottesmore. Home to the 1st and 2nd Battalions.

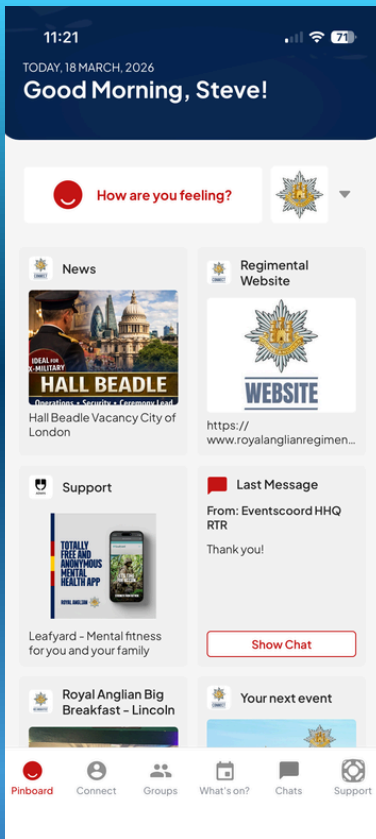
The event will be on Saturday the 12th of September. This is a chance for Royal Anglians past and present to get together for what will be a great day.
